FY 2022 Maximum Property Tax Dollars**

WHEREAS, the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors have considered the proposed FY 2021/2022 county maximum property tax dollars for both General County Services and Rural County Services, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on the county website, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was held on March 16, 2021,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Hamilton County that the maximum property tax dollars for General County Services and Rural County Services for FY 2021/2022 shall not exceed the following:

General County Services	\$6,729,490; an increase of 12.31% from the prior year
Rural County Services	\$2,679,478; an increase of 5.12% from the prior year
