NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO THE ELIGIBLE VOTERS OF HAMILTON COUNTY, IOWA, THAT THE COMBINED CITY & SCHOOL ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2021

The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. **Voters must vote in their precinct of residence.** Please read this notice carefully to determine your correct voting location. Voting locations may have changed for some voters. If you are unsure of your voting precinct for this election, please contact the Hamilton County Auditor & Commissioner of Elections at 515-832-9510, or by email kschaa@hamiltoncounty.org. Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered-such as voters registering to vote on election day-and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if requires) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by 12:00 Noon on Monday, November 8, 2021. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
