What does a Precinct Election Official do?

You would trained to do the following:

1. Prepare a polling place for election
2. Determine the eligibility of voters
3. Instruct voters how to use voting equipment
4. Complete paperwork and close polls

A MAJOR RESPONSIBILITY...

Elections are at the core of our system of government. Seeing that everyone's right to vote is protected - and that we as people are protected against voter fraud - is not responsibility to be taken lightly. We are prepared to give you the training if you are prepared to take responsibility.

Training

- Schools of instruction are held periodically
- Individual training can be scheduled with Election Officials
- New workers receive on the job training from experience workers

Qualifications

- Must be registered to vote in Hamilton County

Work Schedule

- Depending on the availability of workers in your precinct you may work for any other or all of the following:
 - ❖ **City/School Elections** are held in November of odd-numbered years. Polls open from 7AM to 8 PM
 - ❖ **Primary Elections** are held in June of even-numbered years. Polls are open 7 AM to 9 PM.
 - ❖ **General Elections** are held in November of even-numbered years. Polls open 7 AM to 9 PM.
